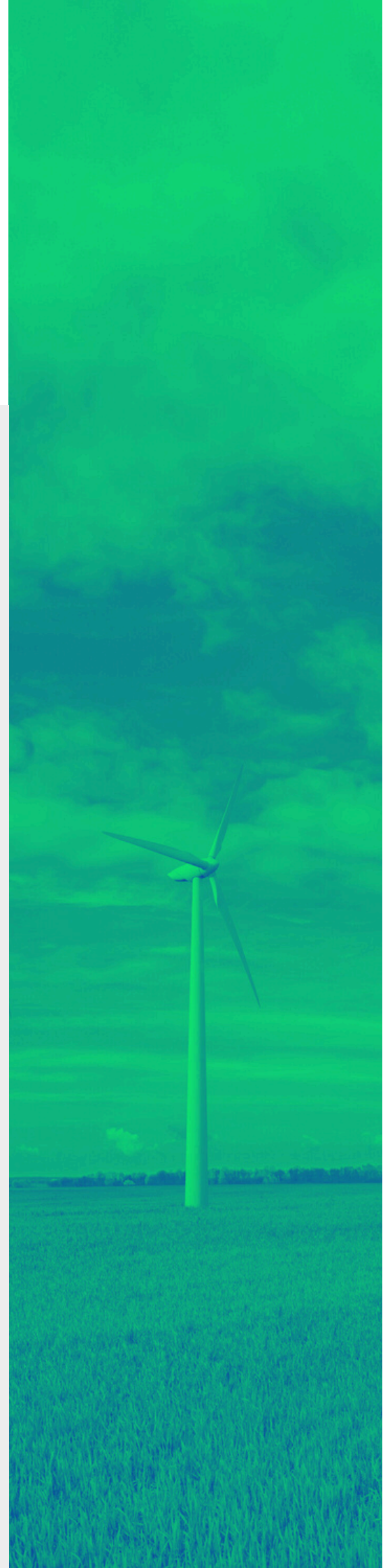
Dear Readers,
