**1 REFUSING
STOPS WASTE BEFORE
IT STARTS.
NO TO UNNECESSARY
PACKAGING,
DISPOSABLES, AND
NON-RECYCLABLE

SYSTEM.**

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**2 REDUCING
GENERATING LESS
WASTE, LIKE CHOOSING
PRODUCTS WITH
MINIMAL PACKAGING.
IT HELPS LOWER THE
AMOUNT OF WASTE
NEEDING DISPOSAL.**

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**3 REUSING
USING ITEMS AGAIN
INSTEAD OF DISCARDING
THEM—LIKE TURNING GLASS
JARS INTO STORAGE. IT
REDUCES DEMAND FOR NEW

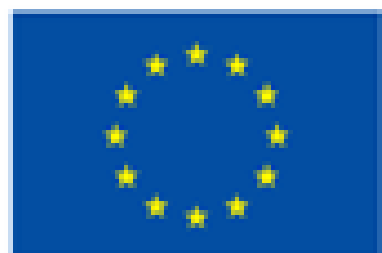
